The 30th Anniversary Event of the Annual Bay to Bay Trailable Yacht Race presented by Hervey Bay Sailing Club and Wide Bay Water Corporation will be sailed by Type 1 Monohulls, Type 2 Sports Monohulls, Type 3 Multihulls and Type 4 Sports Multihulls on the waters of the Great Sandy Strait between Snapper Creek Tin Can Bay and Urangan Hervey Bay on Saturday the 1st and Sunday the 2nd of May 2010

The event offers a souvenir program, souvenir medallion, a photo DVD and a video DVD of the event for every entry, sponsors event carry bag and sticker, free anchorage adjacent to the Tin Can Bay Yacht Club on Friday day, overnight and Saturday morning with a welcome barbecue on Friday night and breakfast on Saturday morning, bus transport between Hervey Bay and Tin Can Bay Friday evening and Saturday morning (\$25), an overnight stop in Garrys Anchorage on Saturday night (byo food, drinks, toilets and sleeping for rafted up small parties and sleeping), fleet starting, finishing, surveillance and limited rescue facilities on Saturday and Sunday, a trophy presentation function at the Hervey Bay Boat Club Urangan Boat Harbour on Sunday night (meals and refreshments available at reasonable cost), results emailed or posted to each entry and local, state and national participation and press coverage.

Two days of CBH (monohulls), SMS (sports monohulls), OMR (multihulls) & PBH (all boats) Type, Division and Class racing and cruising for eligible yachts with details of Types, Divisions, Classes and ratings may be further clarified on the website during the receipt of entries about mid April 2010.

Excellent road, rail and air travel to and from the venue; all levels of quality accommodation at Hervey Bay, Tin Can Bay and Fraser Island; a meet the fleet cruise on Sunday; a range of excellent tourist attractions on the Fraser Coast, Hervey Bay, Maryborough, the Cooloola Coast, Tin Can Bay, Gympie, the Great Sandy Strait and hinterlands all make for an extended family stay to be combined with the Bay to Bay or a fly in fly out for interstate entrants.
