Some facts about the race:

- The first Brisbane to Gladstone Multihull Yacht Race was held in 1965, this year celebrates the 54th sailing of the race. The first race was won by Hedley Nicol aboard Vagabond a 35 foot trimaran.
- The race distance is 308 nautical miles, starting off the Shorncliffe Pier, sailing out of Moreton Bay via Tangalooma and the North West channel, rounding outside Fraser Island, Breaksea Spit and Lady Elliot Island and then finishing off Auckland Creek inside Gladstone Harbour.
- The race record is 16 hours, 28 minutes, 21 seconds for an average speed of 18.7 knots set by *Team Australia*, an ORMA 60 trimaran skippered by Sean Langman, in 2012.
